About the Organizer	<p>Jiangsu Inspection and Quarantine Institute of Quality (hereinafter referred to as JSIQ) was established in 2005 and affiliated with Nanjing Customs District, China. It has been organizing foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China.</p> <p>JSIQ is a scientific research institution engaged in quality research, international exchanges, comprehensive training and management consultation. It now has several departments namely Department of Research on Development, Department of International Exchanges and Cooperation, Department of Comprehensive Training, Department of Consultation on Quality and Department of Comprehensive Management. There are over 40 staff members working with this institution.</p> <p>JSIQ started to organize foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China since 2006, and has organized 302 programs successfully by the end of 2024. Over 9000 customs officials, technicians and participants from other authorities of 153 countries and international organizations from five continents received training during these programs. The contents of training in programs organized by JSIQ focus on a variety of sectors including import and export commodity inspection, entry and exit animal and plant quarantine, entry and exit health quarantine, import and export food safety, Customs administration, standards, metrology, certification and accreditation, market supervision and intellectual property rights; the languages used include English, French, Russian, Mongolian, Lao, Arabic, Spanish, Portuguese and Cambodian. It thus has gained rich experience in foreign-aid training within customs system and achieved fruitful results thereof.</p>	
Training content	<p>1. Main contents of training</p> <p>Lectures, case studies and discussions are arranged covering the following contents: (1) Overview of China (2) International Intellectual Property Legal System (3) China's Trademark Protection System (4) Seeking for Global Ecological Civilization (5) Unfair Competition and Anti-monopoly Regulation of Internet Platforms (6) China's Intellectual Property Protection System (7) Technological Innovation and Intellectual Property Development Trends (8) Intellectual Property Customs Protection. Participants will also have the opportunity to exchange with Chinese officials and experts from Nanjing Customs, China Metrology University, Nanjing University of Science and Technology, Changzhou University, Zhejiang Kin Ding Law Firm, Changzhou Intermediate People's Court and other units.</p> <p>2. Visits and field trips (cities to visit may be adjusted according to actual situations)</p> <p>During the seminar, we will arrange for the participants to visit and inspect Chinese food and daily chemical enterprises, as well as the intellectual property protection center, so that the officials can understand China's intellectual property management system and development level, and arrange special cultural experiences so that the participants can experience China's long history and culture and the fruitful achievements of reform and opening up.</p> <p>Participants will visit China (Changzhou) Intellectual Property Protection Center and other places in Changzhou, Shaowangsheng Food Company and City God Temple Food Company, etc. in Shanghai. In addition, they will also visit Longrich Biotech Co., LTD in Changshu and inspect China's new rural construction in Zhenjiang.</p>
