About the Organizer	<p>Xiamen National Accounting Institute (hereinafter referred to as “XNAI”) was founded in 2002 and is directly affiliated with the Ministry of Finance of the People’s Republic of China. XNAI serves as a well-constructed training base for high-end financial participants actively engaging in the accounting, financial and economic fields. So far, XNAI has organized more than 8000 seminars/ workshops for over 0.8 million trainees.</p> <p>During the opening ceremony of the first Belt and Road Forum for International Cooperation in May 2017, Chinese President Xi Jinping announced that China would be establishing the Research Center for the Belt & Road Financial and Economic Development (hereinafter referred to as “the Research Center”). In June 2017, the Research Center was officially founded with the approval of the Ministry of Finance. XNAI conducts forefront research on financial and economic development and practical issues, forming a financial think tank system composed of five research centers and four research institutes. With the construction of the Research Center, XNAI has achieved solid achievements in research on the “Belt and Road” investment and financing cooperation, ASEAN 10+3 financial cooperation, and subjects related to domestic and foreign financial issues. XNAI is also experienced in holding international workshops and training.</p> <p>Under the guidance of the Ministry of Commerce of the People’s Republic of China and the Academy for International Business Officials (AIBO), XNAI has undertaken five China-aid projects, including the Seminar on Financial Strategy for BRI Partner Countries, the Seminar on Financial Strategy for Developing Countries, the Seminar on Fiscal and Tax Management for BRI Partner Countries and the Seminar on Economic and Trade Cooperation for BRI Partner Countries. Five seminars have arranged lectures and activities for government officials, enterprise and institutional financial practitioners from more than 30 BRI partner countries, including Azerbaijan, Bahrain, Brazil, Cuba, Cyprus, Ethiopia, Gabon, Guyana, Lesotho, Libya, Myanmar, Namibia, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Peru, South Africa, Solomon Islands, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan, Tanzania, Tunisia, Turkmenistan, Uganda, Uzbekistan and Zambia, receiving widespread compliment. Under the guidance of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Finance of the People’s Republic of China, XNAI successfully hosted three international workshops of the “Capacity Building Program for Asian Economic and Financial Talents” for more than 10 ASEAN and Central Asian countries. These training programs offers a variety of courses on topics such as Chinese fiscal and tax system reform, international economic and trade cooperation, tariff policy, international monetary policy, green trade, etc., all of which received well recognition.</p> <p>As a liaison office, XNAI has hosted 5 sessions of the “Belt and Road” National Accounting Standards Cooperation Forum under the guidance of the Accounting Regulatory Department of Ministry of Finance and the China Accounting Standards Committee (CASC); cooperated with China Association for International Economic Cooperation to co-host the Belt and Road High-Quality Development Conference; cooperated with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) to co-host 2 sessions of the Asia-Pacific Anticorruption and Integrity Forum. 	<p>good cooperation with multiple international organizations, including ADB, the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB), the New Development Bank, and the Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation Institute (CI), and has held multiple training programs with the theme on the Belt and Road Initiative, in cooperation with the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration commission of the State Council, the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Security of the People's Republic of China, and the Chinese Institute of Certified Public Accountants.</p> <p>XNAI is located at the southern part of Xiamen, Fujian Province, embraced by the mountains and facing the sea. XNAI features beautiful surroundings and advanced facilities and is a modern, intelligent landscaped institution for training, teaching and research with international standards. XNAI is equipped with 33 teaching facilities, including academic lecture halls, small multi-functional lecture halls, multimedia classrooms, computer classrooms, language labs and a library, and can provide basic equipment services such as projection and other equipment; meanwhile, XNAI is equipped with apartment accommodation with well-equipped facilities, over 1,300 standard guest rooms, suites; it has three halls that can provide corresponding dishes and star-rated hotel services based on demand ; there is a medical room on campus, a comprehensive hospital in Xiamen close to XNAI campus. Main training content</p> <p>(I) Facilitate exchanges among financial and taxation officials and financial management personnel from official department , enterprises and institutions in BRI Partner Countries to enhance professional competencies in fiscal governance.;</p> <p>(II) Share China's fiscal and taxation policy frameworks and reform experience through training programs, demonstrating proven practices to foster policy coordination between China and partner countries;</p> <p>(III) Establish a permanent multilateral dialogue platform through thematic lectures, forum, and field visits, focusing on comparative analysis of fiscal and taxation system reforms, green taxation, doing business environment, governmental procurement systems, green currency, green investment across partner countries, thereby enabling officials and management personnel to identify collaborative pathways for regional economic integration.</p> <p>2.
