About the Organizer	Jiangsu Inspection and Quarantine Institute of Quality (hereinafter referred to as JSIQ) was established in 2005 and affiliated with Nanjing Customs District, China. It is one of the organizers for foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China. JSIQ is a scientific research institution engaged in quality research, international exchanges, comprehensive training and management consultation. It now has several departments namely Department of Research on Development, Department of International Exchanges and Cooperation, Department of Comprehensive Training, Department of Consultation on Quality and Department of Comprehensive Management. There are over 40 staff members working with this institution. JSIQ has been organizing foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China since 2006, and has organized 302 programs successfully by the end of 2024. Main contents of training In the form of lectures, case studies and discussions, the following topics will be covered: (1) Overview of China (2) Overview of Inspection and Quarantine of China Customs (3) Seek Global Ecological Civilization (4) History and Development of Frontier Health Quarantine in China (5)Construction of Health Quarantine Standard System and Laboratory Management (6) Health Quarantine of Land Ports in China (7)Construction of International Health Airports and Health Ports in China (8) Introduction to Regulatory Framework of Customs (9)Port Sanitization and Supervision in China (10)Construction of 'Intelligent Customs'. Participants will have the opportunity to exchange with experts and officials from China Customs. 2. Inspection and visit arrangements (cities of inspection and visit are subject to change based on actual situations) During the seminar, we will arrange for the participants to visit the health quarantine laboratories and relevant enterprises of China Customs. In Changzhou, the participants will visit the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, as well as the Changzhou branch of Jiangsu International Travel Health Care Center. We will organize visits to relevant enterprises in Shanghai and to observe the new rural construction in Zhenjiang. In addition, we will arrange cultural experiences that allow the participants to appreciate China's long history and the fruitful results of the reform and opening up. 3.
