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| About the Organizer                  | <p>The International, Hong Kong and Macau Training Center is mainly engaged in organizing elite individuals from various sectors of society, including international and Hong Kong Macau civil servants, political parties, governments, parliaments, and think tanks, to come to China for training. From 2000 to now, it has held more than 520 international training courses with more than 13,000 trainees, covering 164 countries and regions in Asia, Europe, Africa, America and Oceania. Among them, the topic of “public administration management” has become the international training brand of our center. | Training content                     | <p>The seminar will invite experts and scholars in the field of modernization of the national governance system and governance capability to give lectures to the participants, comprehensively using various teaching methods such as classroom lectures, on-site teaching, cultural experience, investigation, exchange and discussion. The main training contents include China’s development, China’s national governance, China’s economic development and reform and opening-up, and China’s public policy making.</p> <p>1. China’s development (Summary of China’s national conditions): Introduce the general situation of China’s politics, economy, history, culture and other aspects, so as to make the participants understand China preliminarily and provide theoretical basis for later learning and communication.</p>  |  |

2. Xi Jinping's Thought on Socialism with Chinese Characteristics for a New Era: Introduce the formation background, ideological connotation, historical status and world significance of Xi Jinping's thought of socialism with Chinese characteristics for a new era. It explains the basic connotation and logical structure of "10 definite" and "14 insist", and the historic achievements and changes of socialism with Chinese characteristics since it entered the new era. Explain the scientific answer of Xi Jinping's thought of socialism with Chinese characteristics for a new era to the question of China, the question of the world, the question of the people and the question of the time.

3. Modernization of State Governance System and Capacity: Introduction to the organizational structure and operation of the Chinese government; focus on the experience and practices of the Chinese government under the leadership of the Communist Party of China in promoting the modernization of state governance system and capacity in reform, development and stability, economic and social construction and diplomacy.

4. Jointly build the "Belt and Road" high-quality development: introduce the historical inheritance and era background of the "Belt and Road" initiative, the basic principles, operation mechanism, achievements and development prospects of the "Belt and Road" initiative. Highlight the cooperation situation and practical experience of participating in the Belt and Road Initiative in the countries and regions where the trainees are located.

5. To build a "community with a shared future for mankind": introduce the concept and connotation of the community of human destiny, as well as the basic principles, values and paths of action of the community of human destiny. Explains China's experience and practice in building a community of human destiny, and probes into China's role and responsibility in global governance. To explore how countries around the world can strengthen cooperation to jointly meet global challenges and promote common prosperity and development of mankind.

6. China's economic development and reform and opening-up: Introduce the process, characteristics and trends of China's economic development since the reform and opening-up. Explain the achievements of China's economic development and its impact on the world during the 40 years of reform and opening up.

9. Civilization exchange and mutual appreciation: Through the exchange and communication between Chinese experts and participants, we will deepen civilizational and cultural exchange and mutual appreciation among countries. Chinese experts will introduce the origin, present and future of Chinese civilization. Representatives of the participants will share the origins and characteristics of the civilizations of their countries and their cultural exchanges with foreign countries.

Presenter Introduction

1. Shi Hexing: Professor of the National Academy of Governance, Researcher of the National Institute of Governance, Peking University, 1997 Beijing Social Science "100-Person Project" trans-century talents. Mainly engaged in national governance, public ethics, conflict management and other research.

2. Wang Manchuan: Director and Professor of Public Administration Teaching and Research Department of National Academy of Governance, Executive Vice-President and Secretary-General of China Administrative System Reform Research Association, Member of Executive Committee of International Federation of Administrative Colleges and Universities; mainly engaged in research on public management and public policy; served as World Bank for many times. Consultant expert from international organizations such as the United Nations Development Agency.

3. Zhao Lei: Vice President and Professor of the Institute of International Strategy of National Academy of Governance; Member of the "National and Regional Research Expert Committee" of the Ministry of Education, member of the Central Enterprise Youth Federation, Deputy Secretary-General of the Decision Advisory Committee of the National People's Commission of the People's Republic of China, expert group expert of the "Belt and Road" economic and trade cooperation of the Ministry of Commerce; the research fields are international relations, Chinese diplomacy, multilateral diplomacy and cultural soft power. International cooperation and construction of the "Belt and Road" Initiative.

4. Wang Xuebin: Professor of the Department of the Literature and History Teaching and Research of the National Academy of Governance, Director of the Chinese History Teaching

and Research Office, and Nishan Scholar. Doctor of History, Beijing Normal University, Postdoctoral Doctor of Institute of Modern History, Chinese Academy of Social Sciences.  
5. Song Shiming: Second level professor at the CNAG, leader of the Public Administration discipline, doctoral supervisor, and Doctor of Law. The current director of the Public Department Human Resources Teaching and Research Office of the Public Administration Teaching and Research Department of the National School of Administration.

6. Ma Xiaofang: Professor of Economics Department of China National Academy of Governance, Doctor of Economics, Graduate Supervisor. Visiting professor of Academy for International Business Officials, Ministry of Commerce. The research interests include government economic management, international finance and international trade, exchange rate theory and system, and the “Belt and Road” construction.

During the workshop, participants will be arranged to learn and experience the daily Chinese language and Chinese culture. In addition, we have arranged participants to visit other cities to investigate the “one-stop” public service, regional economic development and scenic spots showing the characteristics of China’s economy and culture. Through classroom lectures, on-the-spot teaching and visiting, participants can learn about China’s basic national conditions and government management experience, feel China’s achievements in economy, society, education and cultural construction since the reform and opening up, enhance friendship, expand consensus, strengthen mutual trust and expand cooperation. Further strengthen cooperation and exchanges between China and other developing countries.
