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About the Organizer	<p>The International Poverty Reduction Center in China (IPRCC) was established in May 2005 as one of outcomes of Shanghai Global Conference on Scaling Up Poverty Reduction in 2004. IPRCC was jointly initiated and established by the Chinese government, the UNDP, the World Bank and other international organizations. It is designed for research, training, exchange, collaboration and knowledge sharing in poverty reduction. IPRCC is committed to the internationalization of China's poverty reduction experience, as well as the localization of global experience, so as to forge an integrated platform for poverty reduction and development. Since 2005 to the end of 2024, IPRCC has successfully held 217 seminars, with 15382 participants from 140 countries. IPRCC has developed training textbooks such as "Ten Keys to Understanding China's Poverty Reduction", video textbooks and micro video cases teaching materials. In the central and western regions in China, 15 provinces have been identified as "China Poverty Alleviation Exchange Base". Participants can be arranged to visit the bases for field visits and feel the effects of poverty alleviation policies and practices. IPRCC is also equipped with an international training team that understands business, knows foreign languages and has high quality. At the same time, it has compiled and printed the international training manual for poverty reduction, which has strengthened the standardized management and promoted the high-quality development of project implementation. IPRCC has two training classrooms with an area of 120 square meters, and has the necessary venues and equipment for online training. Training content	<p>The theme of this project is "Rural Development and Poverty Reduction." It focuses on training in the strategic deployment, policy measures, and organizational implementation of integrated rural development and sustainable poverty reduction. It showcases China's policies, implementation models, and experiences learned in optimizing the rural economic structure, strengthening rural public services, and achieving coordinated development of the economy, society, and ecology. It also analyzes the problems and challenges faced by developing countries in rural development and poverty reduction, and explores ways and measures to improve the strategic system and implementation models for rural development and poverty reduction. The activities of the seminar are divided into three parts: Thematic lecture, discussion and exchange and field visits.</p> <p>I. Thematic Lectures: includes 1 public course and 9 core courses.</p> <p>(I) Public Courses</p> <p>Overview of China's national conditions and economic and social development. It mainly introduces China's basic national conditions and the main results, strategic measures, models and mechanisms of economic and social development, as well as experience and inspiration.</p> <p>(II) Core Courses:</p> <p>1. Policy formulation and practical effects of China's industrial poverty alleviation. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy practice, main effects and experience enlightenment of China's industrial poverty alleviation.</p> <p>4. Policy formulation and practical effects of China's employment poverty alleviation. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy practice, main effects and experience enlightenment of China's employment poverty alleviation.</p> <p>5. Policy formulation and practical effects of China's education poverty alleviation. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy practice, main effects and experience enlightenment of China's education poverty alleviation.</p> <p>6.
