About the Organizer	<p>Jiangsu Inspection and Quarantine Institute of Quality (hereinafter referred to as JSIQ) was established in 2005 and affiliated with Nanjing Customs District, China. It has been organizing foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China.</p> <p>JSIQ is a scientific research institution engaged in quality research, international exchanges, comprehensive training and management consultation. It now has several departments namely Department of Research on Development, Department of International Exchanges and Cooperation, Department of Comprehensive Training, Department of Consultation on Quality and Department of Comprehensive Management. There are over 40 staff members working with this institution.</p> <p>JSIQ started to organize foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China since 2006, and has organized 302 programs successfully by the end of 2024. Over 9000 Customs officials, technicians and participants from other authorities of 153 countries and international organizations from five continents received training during these programs. The contents of training in programs organized by JSIQ focus on a variety of sectors including import and export commodity inspection, entry and exit animal and plant quarantine, entry and exit health quarantine, import and export food safety, Customs administration, standards, metrology, certification and accreditation, market supervision and intellectual property rights; the languages used include English, French, Russian, Mongolian, Lao, Arabic, Spanish, Portuguese and Cambodian. It thus has gained rich experience in foreign-aid training within customs system and achieved fruitful results thereof.</p>	
Training content	<p>1. Main contents of training</p> <p>Participants will be invited to attend lectures, case study, discussions that cover the following training contents: (1) Overview of China, (2) Overview of inspection and quarantine of China Customs, (3) Legislation system of the Customs (4) Customs supervision policies in Comprehensive Bonded Area of China, (5) Supervision on posted parcels and luggage by China Customs, (6) Accelerating building a socialist country with improved culture,(7) Supervision work conducted by China Customs at the point of entry, (8) An overview of specialized supervision area of China Customs, (9) Smart Customs of China (10) Prohibition and Limitation Management of Customs, (11) AEO system of China Customs, (12) Innovate follow-up supervision mode to boost trade facilitation, (13) Belt & Road Initiative and bilateral cooperation in inspection and quarantine of Customs, and (14) IRP conducted by Customs. Symposium or discussion among participating countries will be organized during the training course.</p> <p>2. Visits and field trips (city visited may be adjusted according to the practical conditions)</p> <p>Participants will be organized to pay visits to Customs comprehensive bonded area, testing labs affiliated to the Customs and relevant enterprises and so on. It is kindly desired, through these activities, that the participants will be having a good experience in China's profound history and culture and the fruitful achievements since the start of Reform and Opening-up of China and get a better understanding about missions and cargo supervision carried out by China Customs.</p>
