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About the Organizer	Founded in 1964, Jiangxi Vocational College of Foreign Studies is the only higher vocational college dominated by training foreign language and foreign economic and trade application-oriented talents in Jiangxi Province, it is a construction unit of high-standard		

	<p>programs construction plan with Chinese characteristics, a co-developed college of the People's Government of Jiangxi Province and the Ministry of Commerce of China and one of the first batches of MOFCOM Training Bases for International Business Officials. The college is a national high-quality higher vocational college, and one of the first batch of Demonstrative Higher Vocational Colleges in Jiangxi Province. It was awarded the title of one of Top 50 Vocational Colleges of International Influence in China for two consecutive years.</p> <p>The college now has two campuses in Yaohu and Wangcheng respectively. The campuses boast combination of Chinese and western characteristics and modern elegance. The college highlights foreign-oriented running features, sets up 47 majors, involving 11 languages including English, Japanese, German, Korean, French, Arabic, Spanish, Portuguese, Russian, Italian, and Persian, and has rich translation resources and teachers reserve. The college has set up a special foreign aid training agency, equipped with more than 20 full-time management personnel, and hundreds of students are selected to work as volunteers, having created a high-quality, professional and capable foreign aid training management team. Meanwhile, it has a fully equipped hotel integrating training, teaching, conference and leisure, with strong reception capacity, providing participants with comfortable learning and living environment. The college has been the organizer of foreign aid training projects since 2010, covering over 15 fields such as party and government administration, economy and trade, education, energy, etc. And these projects involve technical training courses and seminars at ministerial and director's level. The foreign aid training projects keep in line with the actual needs of developing countries, and pay attention to the combination of theory and practice. Through field visits and exchanges, combining case teaching and experience sharing, and systematically showing China's experience in governance, we have told China's stories well, and deepened the practical cooperation and people-to-people exchanges between China and developing countries. As of January 2025, the college had successfully organized 304 foreign aid training projects, including 3 held abroad, and had trained 7,703 participants from 140 countries and regions. Main courses (1) National Conditions of China: introduce the current development, development concepts and development initiatives of China; (2) The Belt and Road Initiative and International Cooperation: introduce the connotation and achievements of China's Belt and Road Initiative, as well as the prospect for the cooperation with developing countries within the framework of the Belt and Road Initiative; (3) Journey of China's Reform and Opening-up: introduce the historical process, development achievements and experience of China's reform and opening-up; (4) China's Civil Servant System: introduce the formation process, basic principles and characteristics, obligations and rights of China's civil servant system, as well as the contents of the civil servant system (assessment, recruitment, rewards and punishments, training, promotion, exchange, withdrawal, condition guarantee, etc.); (5) Leadership Theory and Development: introduce leadership theory, leadership in public sectors, young leaders' growth and training, and experience and inspiration in leadership development at home and abroad; (6) Civil Servant Governance Capacity Building: share civil servant capacity quality model and path, measures to enhance civil servants' capacity, experience of civil servant capacity building in China, with emphasis on civil servants' public service capacity, and case analysis; (7) Human Resource Training and Leadership Development: introduce DNA training (Dream, Nalp and Action training) and leadership quality model, including the core work of excellent leadership, the construction of leadership authority, interest coordination, cultural construction, etc. (8) Capacity Building of Young Leaders: introduce the growth and training of young leaders, youth empowerment and international youth leadership, Young Global Leaders and Asia-Pacific Elite Leaders Initiative, measures to promote youth development and foster international leadership; (9) Chinese Government's Practice of Building Public Service Systems: introduce the</p>

	<p>development process and practical experience of Chinese Government's public service systems, and the public service capacity building of civil servants;</p> <p>(10) "Internet+" Strategy and Innovation in Chinese Government Management: introduce the opportunities of government innovation, Chinese Government's innovation strategy and innovation practice on the basis of "internet+", and look ahead China's "digital government";</p> <p>(11) Chinese Government's Response to Public Crises: Concept, Mechanism, Practice: introduce the necessity of government management for public crises, prevention of, response to and afterwards reply to the community public crises;</p> <p>(12) Equal Access to Basic Public Services and Common Prosperity: introduce the provision and development of public services, the specific content and effectiveness of social security policies, the current situation of equal access to basic public services, the goal of common prosperity, and the internal logic of equal access to basic public services and common prosperity.</p> <p>2.
