About the Organizer	<p>The International Poverty Reduction Center in China (IPRCC) was established in May 2005 as one of outcomes of Shanghai Global Conference on Scaling Up Poverty Reduction in 2004. IPRCC was jointly initiated and established by the Chinese government, the UNDP, the World Bank and other international organizations. It is designed for research, training, exchange, collaboration and knowledge sharing in poverty reduction. IPRCC is committed to the internationalization of China's poverty reduction experience, as well as the localization of global experience, so as to forge an integrated platform for poverty reduction and development. Since 2005 to the end of 2024, IPRCC has successfully held 217 seminars, with 15382 participants from 140 countries. IPRCC has developed training textbooks such as "Ten Keys to Understanding China's Poverty Reduction", video textbooks and micro video cases teaching materials. In the central and western regions in China, 15 provinces have been identified as "China Poverty Alleviation Exchange Base". Participants can be arranged to visit the bases for field visits and feel the effects of poverty alleviation policies and practices. IPRCC is also equipped with an international training team that understands business, knows foreign languages and has high quality. At the same time, it has compiled and printed the international training manual for poverty reduction, which has strengthened the standardized management and promoted the high-quality development of project implementation. Seminar Content	<p>On September 21, 2021, President Xi Jinping proposed the Global Development Initiative during the general debate of the 76th United Nations General Assembly, which focuses on the most pressing issues faced by developing countries, such as poverty reduction and eradication, food security, economic recovery, education and health, aiming to accelerate the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Development proposed by the United Nations. As a responsible major country, China is committed to eradicating poverty itself, while cooperating with other developing countries in poverty reduction. The theme of this program is "Poverty Reduction and Development under the Global Development Initiative". It invites government officials and researchers from relevant departments of poverty reduction and development in developing countries to participate in the seminar. It will explain China's global development initiative and its strategic policies, institutional mechanisms and progress in promoting poverty reduction and development, analyze the problems and challenges faced by developing countries in eradicating poverty and promoting coordinated economic and social development, and explore policies, measures and ways to comprehensively eliminate poverty, build inclusive growth mechanisms, optimize economic and social development patterns, and accelerate the process of national modernization. The training activities of the seminar are divided into three parts: Thematic lecture, discussion and exchange and field visit.</p> <p>I. Thematic Lecture: includes 2 public courses and 7 core courses.</p> <p>(I) Common Courses</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Overview of China's national conditions and economic and social development. This course mainly introduces China's basic national conditions and the main results, strategic measures, models and mechanisms of economic and social development, as well as experience and inspiration. 2. Specific practices of China's forestry industry in response to climate change. This course mainly introduces the strategies, policies and measures, institutional mechanism, main achievements and experience of China's forestry industry in addressing climate change. <p>(II) Core Courses:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Global Development Initiative and China's international development cooperation. This course mainly introduces China's policies, measures, implementation models and experience in promoting the implementation of global development initiatives and strengthening international cooperation in poverty reduction and development. 2. China's poverty alleviation policies and practices. This course mainly introduces the strategic plan, implementation mechanism, policy measures, main results and experience inspiration of China's poverty alleviation. 3. Science and technology innovation policy and practice in China. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy measures, main effects and experience enlightenment of China's science and technology innovation. 4. China's ecological construction and green development policies and practices. This course mainly introduces China's strategic framework, policies and measures, implementation model, work effect and experience inspiration for promoting ecological construction and strengthening green development. 5. China's International Trade and Investment Cooperation Policies and Practices. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy measures, implementation mode, work effectiveness and experience of China's international trade and investment cooperation. 6. Digital economy, agricultural and rural development, and poverty reduction. This course mainly introduces how to use digital technology to promote the development of agricultural production, facilitate the sale of agricultural products and the purchase of agricultural production materials through rural e-commerce, and promote farmers' income increase and poverty reduction. 7. The policy formulation and implementation achievement of poverty alleviation policies by local provinces and regions. This course mainly introduces the policy formulation of poverty alleviation planning, policies and measures, implementation mode and experience and inspiration of local provinces and regions. <p>(III) Information about speakers</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
