About the Organizer	<p>Jiangsu Inspection and Quarantine Institute of Quality (hereinafter referred to as JSIQ) was established in 2005 and affiliated with Nanjing Customs District, China. It has been organizing foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China.</p> <p>JSIQ is a scientific research institution engaged in quality research, international exchanges, comprehensive training and management consultation. It now has several departments namely Department of Research on Development, Department of International Exchanges and Cooperation, Department of Comprehensive Training, Department of Consultation on Quality and Department of Comprehensive Management. There are over 40 staff members working with this institution.</p> <p>JSIQ started to organize foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China since 2006, and has organized 302 programs successfully by the end of 2024. Over 9000 Customs officials, technicians and participants from other authorities of 153 countries and international organizations covering five continents received training during these programs. The contents of training in programs organized by JSIQ focus on a variety of sectors including import and export commodity inspection, entry and exit animal and plant quarantine, entry and exit health quarantine, import and export food safety, Customs administration, standards, metrology, certification and accreditation, market supervision and intellectual property rights; the languages used include English, French, Russian, Mongolian, Lao, Arabic, Spanish, Portuguese and Cambodian. It thus has gained rich experience in foreign-aid training within customs system and achieved fruitful results thereof.</p>	
Training content	<p>1. Main contents of training</p> <p>The seminar will be conducted through lectures, case exchange and discussion sessions, etc., to jointly explore the standardization work of customs inspection and quarantine technical specifications with the officials from the "Belt and Road" countries participating in the seminar. The arrangements will be: (1) Overview of China (2) Overview of Standardization in China (3) Overview of China's Customs Inspection and Quarantine (4) Access and Practice of Entry and Exit Animal Quarantine (5) Seeking Global Ecological Civilization (6) Introduction to the Customs Regulatory System (7) Inspection and Quarantine Supervision of Import and Export Animal Derived Food in China (8) Introduction to the Access Work of Entry Plant Quarantine in China (9) "Smart Customs" construction. Discussions will be held with officials and experts from the customs system.</p> <p>2. Visits and Investigation Arrangements (visiting city may be adjusted according to the practical conditions)</p> <p>During the seminar, we will arrange for the participants to visit the customs laboratory and production, processing and storage enterprises, so that officials can understand the inspection and quarantine technology and standardized management of China's customs, and deepen the understanding of the technical specification standardization work of China's customs. Meanwhile, special cultural experiences are arranged to allow participants to feel China's long</p>	

	<p>history and culture as well as the fruitful achievements of reform and opening up. In Changzhou, the participants will be arranged to visit the National Key Laboratory of Food Contact Materials Testing and the National Key Laboratory of Chemical Classification, Identification and Evaluation, and will also go to Changzhou Hongmei Dairy Co., Ltd. for a visit and investigation on dairy product processing and the supervision of dairy product import and export. In other places, the participants of the seminar will be organized to visit Shanghai, the Shanghai Shao Wansheng Food Company and the Laochenghuangmiao Food Store, and visit Zhenjiang City to investigate the construction of new rural areas in China.</p> <p>3.
