Training content	I. Main Training Content Commissioned by the Ministry of Commerce of the People's Republic of China, Beijing Chinese Language and Culture College will host the "Seminar on Chinese Culture for Government Officials from Developing Countries" in Beijing from November 4, 2025 to November 24,2025, spanning 21 days. The training format includes classroom lectures, cultural experiences, panel discussions, and field visits. Core courses consist of: 1. Knowledge lectures: national conditions, culture, folklore; 2. Cultural experiences: music, handicrafts, calligraphy. This program integrates classroom teaching with social practice. During the training, participants will conduct field visits to Beijing's culture and folk customs, as well as travel to Haikou City, Wenchang City, Qionghai City and Wuzhishan City in Hainan Province for on-site inspections, enabling them to personally experience China's cultural and social development. Through these activities, participants will gain a profound understanding of Chinese culture. Upon completion, participants will enhance their daily conversation skills and basic reading and writing abilities in Chinese, and deepen their knowledge of Chinese culture, society, and policies, fostering closer people-to-people ties and strengthening friendly relations between China and developing countries.				

II. Field Visit Arrangements

Beyond the classroom, field visits within and outside Beijing will be organized to practice Chinese in real-life contexts, appreciate China's historical depth, and experience the charm of the Chinese language and culture, as well as "China's rapid development" and its economic achievements.

- Beijing City: Visit iconic landmarks such as the Great Wall, Temple of Heaven, and Capital Museum (approximately 2 days).
- Other Regions: Travel by high-speed rail / flight to Haikou City, Wenchang City, Qionghai City, Wuzhishan City, Hainan Province:
- Haikou City: Visits the Qilou Old Street in the city center to experience unique Nanyang culture and Qiong opera art; visits Feng Xiaogang Film City to feel the cultural atmosphere of the Republican era.
- Wenchang City: Visits the Wenchang Aerospace Science Popularization Center to gain an in-depth understanding of China's cutting-edge aerospace technology; explore the Shiba Xing Village to experience the overseas Chinese cultural heritage and well-preserved Ming and Qing dynasty ancient architecture.
- Qionghai City: Visits Boao Lecheng International Medical Tourism Pilot Zone to understand its unique positioning as a medical tourism destination.
- Wuzhishan City: Immerse in the Li and Miao culture village, visits the Hainan Ethnic Museum located in the city center, and deeply experience the unique charm of Hainan's minority cultures.

Throughout the seven-day itinerary, participants deeply explored and experienced the allure of Hainan Free Trade Port, China's key gateway for new-era openness, through a combination of site visits, interactive exchanges, and reflective thinking.

The cities to be visited may be adjusted according to the actual situation.

III. Speakers

Renowned Chinese language teachers from our college will deliver foundational courses. Experts and scholars with senior professional titles from within and outside the college will teach specialized courses on Chinese culture, arts, national conditions, folklore, politics, and economics.
