About the Organizer	<p>The University of International Business and Economics (UIBE), founded in 1951, is a national key university under the leadership of the Ministry of Education. Since 2000, under the authorizing of the Ministry of Commerce, UIBE have undertaken more than 80 bilateral and multilateral official training programs, with 1988 participants. The training fields mainly include economy and trade, finance, investment, taxation, customs, corporate management, law, diplomacy, etc. The training languages are English, French, Russian, Spanish, Portuguese, etc. All the seminars have achieved good results. UIBE has significant advantages in foreign language majors and is one of the 15 national key foreign language universities.</p>	
Training content	<p>This seminar mainly includes two parts: lectures and visits.</p> <p>The lectures include: China's basic National Conditions; China's economic profile; Achievements since reform and opening up; China's foreign policy, the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) and the Paris Agreement, the multilateral mechanisms of global climate governance and the roles played by international organizations, international climate regulations and carbon emission trading mechanisms, green finance and climate - related funds, international climate adaptation and mitigation policies, China's policy system and strategies for dealing with climate change, China's role and contributions in international climate governance, the basic theories and practices of climate diplomacy, international climate negotiation techniques and strategies, the interests and cooperation of developing countries in climate diplomacy, national climate governance strategic planning and policy design, as well as public participation and social synergy in climate governance.. The training courses are given by government officials and experts and scholars from the Ministry of Commerce, the University of International Business and Economics and the Diplomatic Institute.</p> <p>Visits: The seminar will arrange for officials to conduct on-site inspections in Beijing city and Shandong Province Qingdao City and Yantai City. They will gain an in-depth understanding of the positive achievements made by Shandong Province in addressing climate change. The carbon dioxide emission intensity has been continuously decreasing, the total greenhouse gas</p>	

	<p>emissions have been effectively controlled, and the capacity for climate governance has been significantly enhanced. A new situation in climate change response work has been initially formed, which is coordinated with economic and social development, compatible with the construction of ecological civilization, and integrated with the protection of the ecological environment. Through these on-site inspections, the trainees can directly experience China's achievements in ecological governance, deeply understand the ecological and cultural concept of "harmony between man and nature", and draw on this experience for the ecological governance of their own countries.
