MPAAI launches Cybersecurity Awareness Workshops
"Cyber Safety Starts with You - Stay Safe, Stay Secure, Stay Connected"

The Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago (GoRTT), through the Ministry of Public Administration and Artificial Intelligence (MPAAI) is hosting its 2025 Cybersecurity Awareness Month campaign, featuring a series of immersive "*Cybersecure Saturdays*" workshops throughout the month of October. The initiative is aimed at empowering citizens with practical knowledge and tools to stay secure in a digital-first environment.

The campaign theme, "***Cyber Safety Starts with You – Stay Safe, Stay Secure, Stay Connected***" aims to engender a proactive approach to personal responsibility in the cyberspace through hands-on, hybrid workshops at 23 ICT Access Centre locations on Saturday, October 11, 18, and 25 2025 respectively. Through live demonstrations and insightful discussion, attendees will gain meaningful strategies to safeguard their data, protect against scams, and foster secure digital habits. Each Saturday will include morning and afternoon sessions designed to guide individuals, families, and professionals in navigating digital risks with confidence.

The Ministry will deliver this initiative in close collaboration with both public and private sector partners, including the Trinidad and Tobago Cyber Security Incident Response Team (TT-CSIRT), Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force (TTDF), Trinidad and Tobago Police Service's Cyber & Social Media Unit (TTPS CSMU), CARICOM IMPACS, iGovTT, Fortinet, RSC International, Cisco Systems, and the Computer Forensics and Security Institute (CFSI).

Cybersecurity has evolved beyond a technical challenge and into a national priority, particularly with the growing presence of Artificial Intelligence in the public domain. As the Ministry advances its mission towards a digitally connected society, this campaign
